Purchasers of Energy-Efficient Electronics May Get up To 50,000 Yen of Support

The city is distributing support funds to people who buy new eligible home electronics, in order to reduce greenhouse gas emissions. Please see the city website for application documents and other details.

Timeframe: June 23rd (Mon) – December 26th (Fri)

 $ilde{x}$ Applications will not be taken after the budget limit has been reached.

Eligible electronics:

- Air conditioners (that meet at least 100% of the standards for energy conservation for the year 2027)
- Electric refrigerators (that meet at least 100% of the standards for energy conservation for the year 2021)
- ☆ Limited to items bought between June 23rd and November 30th at shops registered with Oshu Eco Offices.

Amount: Up to one third of the price of the electronic item (excluding tax.) Up to 50,000 yen, rounded down to the nearest 100 yen.

Other information:

- You can apply for one electronic per household at a time.
- People who have gotten these support funds before, and people who live in the same household as someone who has gotten these support funds, are not eligible.
- When you apply, you will need a picture of the product quality label, or a copy of the warranty, that shows the
 model number of the old electronic. (It's recommended to prepare this before purchasing the new electronic.)
