### Starting in August, Please Use a My Number Card or Certificate of Eligibility

National Health Insurance cards and Medical Insurance Cards for the Latter-Stage Elderly will expire on July 31<sup>st</sup>. Paper insurance cards, as they've been up till now, won't be newly issued – instead, we will be moving towards a system based on using My Number cards as health insurance cards (as Myna health insurance cards.) Once those cards are expired, please show either your Myna health insurance card or your certificate of eligibility, which can be used the same as a health insurance card, when you go to the doctor or pharmacy.
