

About Bringing Garbage Directly to the Tanko Regional Sanitation Center

If you want to get rid of garbage but it's not a collection day, or if you have a lot of garbage at once due to moving or similar circumstances, or if you need to dispose of garbage that won't fit in an official garbage bag, please bring it directly to the Tanko Regional Sanitation Center. There's no need to use an official bag in this case.

Hours

Open Monday-Friday from 8:45AM – 4:45PM.

Closed Saturdays, Sundays, national holidays, and December 29th – January 3rd.

The center is also open to collect household garbage from 8:45AM – 11:45AM on the third Sunday of every month (※ 4th Sunday in May.)

However, there are times when the center is open or closed irregularly, so please contact the Center directly to check.

Cost of disposal

Fees are as follows:

What can and can't be brought to the Center?

Rules vary throughout Oshu about placing garbage out at garbage stations, so please contact the Center directly to check.

Bringing garbage to the Center without properly sorting it may impact the functioning of the waste management facility – for example, a wire or similar items mixed in may cause the incinerator to be temporarily shut down. Please make sure to carefully sort garbage into “burnable” or “unburnable” based on whether the components are burnable or not.
