

Plastic Products are not All Recyclable!

Only plastic packaging with the プラ mark to the right is recyclable. Other plastic products should go in burnables.

Clean plastic packaging that was used for goods (with the プラ mark)

× Things that can't be recycled × → To burnables! !

Hard-to-clean plastics (even with the プラ mark)

Detergent/shampoo bottles Mayo/ketchup bottles Retort pouches

No raw garbage or dirty plastics in recycling!

If items are soiled, that can become the source of bad smells at collection time. Also, mold can grow in the time it takes for recycling to be done, and items may no longer be recyclable. This can become a hindrance to recycling.
