

Notice to All New Parents in Oshu

Congratulations on the birth of your child! Please avail yourself of Oshu's new parent support systems, to ensure your peace of mind in the postpartum period.

New Parent Support Funds

All new parents with an Oshu city address are eligible for 20,000 yen per baby, as financial aid to help with transport fees etc. for well infant checkups and postpartum healthcare. You can apply at the same time as other birth-related procedures. You cannot apply after moving out of Oshu.

- New parents who gave birth while having an Oshu city address may apply.
- What to bring: A copy of the Birthing Conditions page of the Health Handbook, your bankbook or something that shows your bank account number, and the postpartum person's ID (My Number card, driver's license, etc.)
- Application deadline: 6 months after giving birth

Lodging Aid for Pregnancy

People who used a lodging facility until labor & delivery on or after April 1st, 2022 can have some of their fees subsidized. You cannot apply after moving out of Oshu.

- The pregnant person themselves and a companion may apply. Companions who live outside of Oshu are still eligible.
- The upper limit is 5,000 yen per person per night, for up to 3 nights.
- What to bring: A copy of the Birthing Conditions page of the Health Handbook, the receipt from the lodging facility, your bankbook or something that shows your bank account number, and the postpartum person's ID (My Number card, driver's license, etc.)
- Application deadline: 6 months after giving birth; services are available once per birth

Subsidized Taxi Tickets for Pregnancy (received while pregnant)

When you take a taxi for a doctor's appointment or similar, show your Health Handbook and use the subsidized tickets. Tickets are valid for up to one year after the issue date on the Health Handbook.
